

## Pizza Days

On your grade's assigned pizza day (which is only three times a year) your Room Directors should call their portion of the class list to recruit five or six volunteers to help. Please have volunteers arrive at 11:00 am.

Take out approximately 350-400 paper plates and napkins. (These are kept in the SJMC closet.) Stack plates and napkins together. The children will file in to get their pizza. To ease confusion, plates with two slices should be placed at the end of the table. Those students getting two slices will come through the line first. A bag of chips is provided with every slice of pizza.

When lunch is over, return all unused plates, napkins and chips to the closets.

Remind people to record their time for fair share hours with Sister Winifred.

Also, when trying to recruit volunteers, let people know it is OK to bring small children along if necessary. Pizza can be ordered for those children as well by sending in money with the school-age sibling.
